AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT

WITH: REDFLEX TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, INC.

FOR: PHOTO RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

This Amendment to the existing Agreement is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF CULVER CITY, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "City," and REDFLEX TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, INC. hereinafter referred to as "Redflex."

WHEREAS, on or about March 28, 2007, the parties entered into a contract for Redflex to provide services and equipment for the City's Photo Red Light Enforcement Program (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to modify and amend certain provisions of the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, City and Redflex mutually agree as follows:

1. Exhibit B to the Agreement, entitled "Compensation," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Commencing on the date of execution of this agreement, Customer shall be obligated to pay Redflex a fixed fee of \$4,150 per month for each Designated Intersection Approach ("Fixed Fee") as full remuneration for performing all of the services contemplated in this Agreement.

All newly constructed red light camera systems beyond the existing twenty systems will be charged at \$6,030 per monitored approach.

BUSINESS ASSUMPTIONS FOR ALL PRICING OPTIONS:

A. Redflex construction will be able to utilize existing conduit for installation where space is available.

B. In alternate years commencing on the anniversary date in 2009 of the execution of this agreement, the pricing will increase by 2%.

C. A monthly late fee of 1.5% is payable for amounts remaining unpaid 45 days from date of invoice.

2. Except as expressly set forth herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Amendment shall be effective on 12-1- 2009.




