TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

Christopher Jagard, counsel for Respondents and Scott Oborne, counsel for Petitioner, respectfully move this Court for an order staying all proceedings in this case for 120 days from the date of the order hereon, or until either party files a request for a scheduling conference.

Counsel further request that this Court delay issuing a scheduling or briefing order and either delay or vacate the current Case Management Conference and trial set for February 26, 2014 in this matter.

The reasons that the parties are requesting a stay are (1) there is a reasonable chance that this matter will be informally resolved through negotiations with the Department of Industrial Relations together with various civil wage and penalty assessments that are pending against Petitioner and (2) in the event said negotiations are not successful in resolving this matter, Petitioner intends to seek to join related civil wage and penalty assessment appeals with the current action in order to utilize the Court's time in the most efficient manner.

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the Parties through their respective counsel of record:

- 1. That all proceedings in this action shall be stayed for a period of 120 days from the date of the order hereon.
- 2. The current Case Management Conference and trial set for February 26, 2014 be vacated or set over accordingly pursuant to the stay.
