RE: Term Extension of June 13, 2008 Agreement

Dear Lieutenant Brian Campagna:

This letter is to confirm the Parties' agreement to extend the Term provided for in Section 5 of the June 13, 2008 Agreement between the City of Napa and Redflex Traffic Systems Inc. for Automated Photo Enforcement Cameras (the "Original Agreement"), which Original Agreement was amended or extended on July 21, 2011, June 11, 2012, June 17, 2013, June 5, 2014, August 31, 2014, and August 12, 2015 (collectively, the "Agreement"). Specifically, the Parties agree that the Term shall be extended on a month-to-month basis upon the expiration of the current Term on August 31, 2016 until the earlier of (1) February 28, 2017, (2) termination, or (3) the Parties enter into a new contract for automated photo enforcement cameras; provided, however, that either Party may terminate this extension upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.

Except as expressly modified in this letter, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
